

Celebrity Tomatoes (Hybrid)

Growth Habit: Semi-determinate to indeterminate, with a vigorous, vining growth habit that requires staking or trellising for support. These plants typically reach heights of 4 to 5 feet tall and continue to produce fruit throughout the season until frost.

Best Uses: Fresh eating, slicing, sandwiches, salads, and canning. Celebrity tomatoes are known for their well-balanced, mildly sweet flavor and medium-sized fruits, making them versatile for various culinary applications.

Growing Information:

- Full sun (at least 6 hours of direct sunlight)
- Well-draining, fertile soil with a pH of 6.0 to 6.8
- Start seeds indoors 6 to 8 weeks before the last frost
- Transplant seedlings outdoors after hardening off
- Space plants 24 to 36 inches apart

Maintenance Information:

- Water consistently, providing 1 to 2 inches of water per week
- Fertilize with a balanced tomato fertilizer every 3 to 4 weeks
- Prune suckers and lower leaves to encourage fruit production and maintain plant structure

Pest Management:

- Monitor for common tomato pests like aphids, whiteflies, and spider mites
- Watch for signs of fungal diseases like early blight and late blight, and remove infected leaves promptly

Companion Plants:

- Good companion plants for Celebrity tomatoes include basil, marigolds, and nasturtiums, which help repel pests and promote beneficial insects.
