<u>Mini Siam Tomatoes (Heirloom)</u>

Growth Habit: Compact, determinate growth habit, reaching 12 to 18 inches tall and wide. Suitable for container gardening and small spaces.

Best Uses: Fresh eating, snacking, and adding to salads. Known for their sweet, tropical flavor and small size, these tomatoes are perfect for a quick snack or adding a burst of flavor to dishes.

Growing Information:

- Full sun (at least 6 hours of direct sunlight)
- Well-draining soil with a pH of 6.0 to 6.8
- Start seeds indoors 6 to 8 weeks before the last frost
